**You can reserve and paint your very own parking spot for the
2020—2021 school year!**

Don't have a car? Don't worry! You can still reserve a space and paint a spot!

If you are a Senior during the 2020—2021 school year and wish to have a RESERVED parking spot, you must:

1. Complete a Senior Parking Design Request
2. Complete a Senior Parking Spot Agreement
3. Have no OUTSTANDING STUDENT OBLIGATIONS
4. Sign the MHS Student Driving Agreement
5. Pay a paint cleaning fee of \$40.00

**All designs must be completed and submitted for review on or by :
FRIDAY— August 7, 2020 to the MHS Reception Desk.**

If you wish to drive a vehicle to school, you must:

1. Purchase a student parking permit for the 2020-2021 school year - \$10.00 permit cost
2. Provide proof of insurance of the vehicle that will be driven to MHS with the car model and make listed on the policy
3. Provide a copy of your Texas Drivers License

The Students Code of Conduct and all local laws will be enforced at all times. Wording or markings of any drug/drug paraphernalia, drug use, slander, slang, racism, gangs, or s4exual connotation will lead to a punishment and/or criminal action. At any time during the school year, the MHS administrative team reserves the right to remover your painting/privilege to paint if any of the above occur.

Student Parking Space Rules & Guidelines

In order to obtain a parking permit, students must follow the rules/guidelines outlined below:

- Purchase an appropriate parking pass from the Assistant Principals' Office
 - * In the event a student obtains a parking pass from another student or falsifies a parking pass at any time, the student will lose privileges to drive and park on campus, as determined by a campus administrator.
- Follow all Marion ISD Student Code of Conduct Rules.
 - * Please note that if a student is found with any ILLEGAL SUBSTANCE OR PROHIBITED ITEM while on any MISD property, the student WILL lose their privilege to drive to and park on campus
- Finally, please note that:
 - * The student is responsible for purchasing paint.
 - * Parking lines or parking space numbers may not be covered.
 - * Student must clean spills and discard all unused materials.
 - * Student's first name must be painted somewhere on the parking spot. A nickname will not suffice.
 - * **Starting on June 1, 2021 parking spots will be painted over by the MHS administration in preparation for the 2021-2022 school year.**
- All designs for painted parking spaces are due no later than Friday, August 7, 2020 at 4:00pm to the MHS Front Office. This will allow time to review designs and communicate any changes that may need to be made.
- Checks should be made payable to Marion High School.
- Students may start dropping off design requests as early as August 3th, 2020 to the front office or email them to JSTEWART@MARIONISD.NET. If you have any questions, please contact the front office at (830) 914-1075.
- Remember, purchasing a student parking spot is completely optional. There will be parking available for students who do not wish to purchase and decorate a parking spot.

PROHIBITED ITEMS WILL BE PAINTED OVER AT THE DISCRETION OF THE ADMINISTRATION TEAM, AND / OR SECURITY OFFICER.

Disciplinary and Criminal Actions may be taken if designs are inappropriate. If this happens you will be forfeiting your right to a parking space and / or to drive on campus.

Painting of Senior Parking Spaces

Seniors will be allowed to paint their designated parking spaces beginning August 3rd from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm and ending on August 11, 2020.

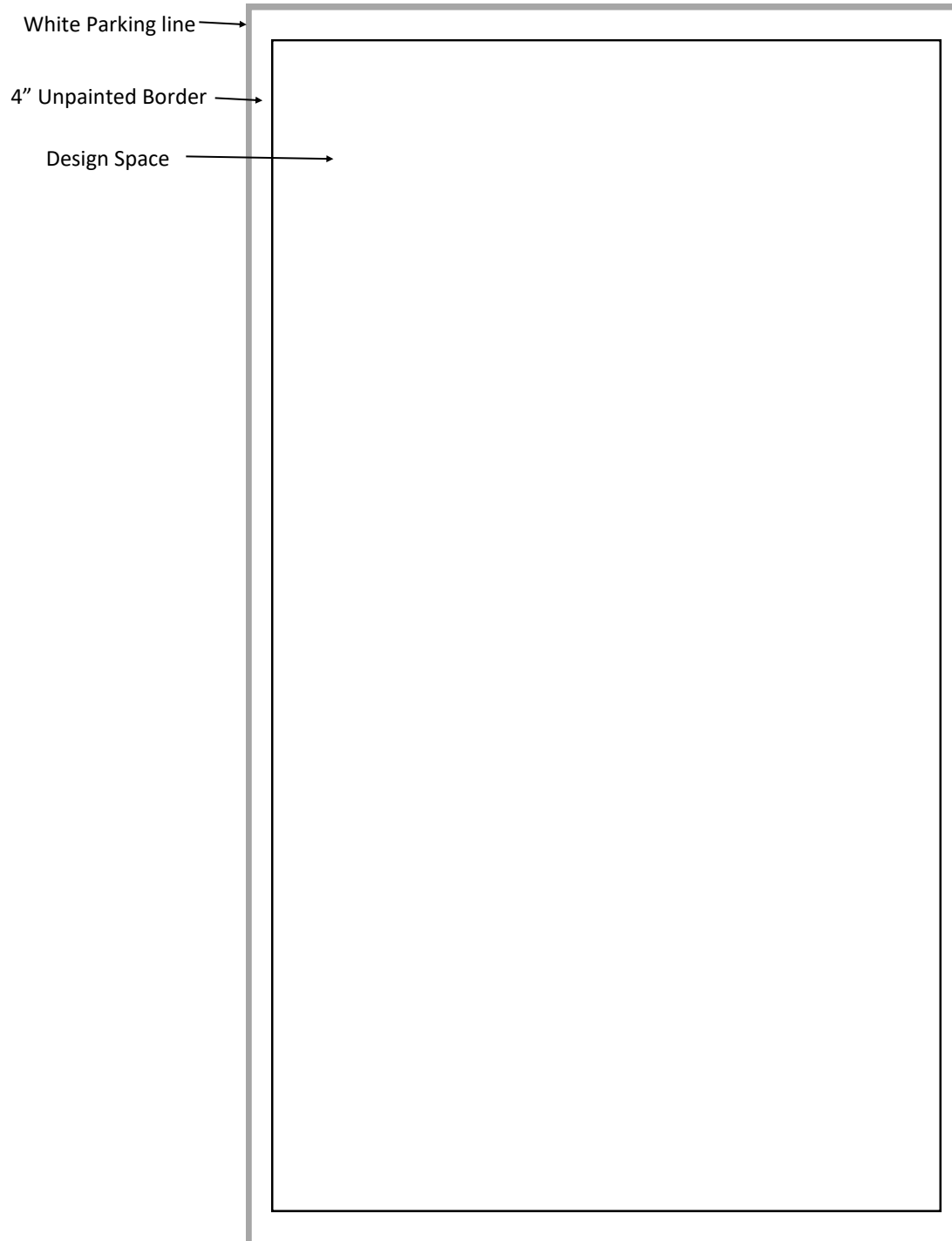
In order to follow all county and district codes and regulations, please note the guidelines below that **MUST BE FOLLOWED** for the painted parking spaces.

- 1. Students must purchase their own water based exterior latex paint.**
 - * This type of paint can be found at retail stores like Lowes, Home Depot and Helping Hand Hardware.
 - * This is the only type of paint that can be used on the MHS Parking Lot.
 - NO REFLECTIVE PAINT
 - NO SPRAY PAINT
 - NO FLOURESCENT PAINT
- 2. Students must keep a 4” unpainted border between the white parking lines and the paint in their parking spot (please use blue painters tape).**
- 3. Any artwork depicting items, symbols, or language that MHS administration deems inappropriate will not be allowed.**
- 4. Student’s first name must be painted somewhere on the parking spot. A nickname will NOT suffice.**
- 5. Parking lines or parking space numbers may not be covered.**

Painting of Senior Parking Spaces

This design sheet MUST be done in COLOR and MUST represent EXACTLY what will be painted on your parking space if it is accepted.

- You may begin submitting designs at 8:00 am on August 3, 2020
- The deadline to submit designs is August 7, 2020 at 4:00 pm
- Painting of assigned parking spaces will be held from August 3—August 11, 2020—8:00 am—4:00 pm each day
- In the event that your design is unacceptable, a member of the MHS staff will communicate with you, via email or phone to let you know about the decision and explain the process that needs to be taken to make appropriate changes.

Working or marks or drugs, drug paraphernalia, slander, slang, racism, gangs, or sexual connotation will lead to punishments and /or criminal action. At any time during the year, MHS reserves the right to remove the Senior Parking Space Painting privilege if any of the above occurs. All paint, supplies and clean-up are the responsibility of the student.

Additionally, a student may lose all parking privileges if the student is found with Any illegal substances ro prohibited items, as determined by the Marion ISD Student Code of Conduct while on any Marion Independent School District Property.
