I hope you are enjoying your summer and this letter finds things going well. It is a great time to be a Bulldog! The month of July is going to be important to your preparation for the upcoming football season. It is important that we are making every effort to get bigger, faster and stronger. I also wanted to take time to give you some upcoming dates so that you can plan accordingly.

WEIGHT ROOM HOURS

As a reminder, the weight room is open Monday through Thursday until 5:00pm. Strength camp continues to run Monday through Thursday 7:00am to 9:00am. Make sure you are getting a lift 3 to 4 times a week with a mix of conditioning. Your commitment and self-discipline in July will make for a smooth transition in August.

PHYSICALS

MISD requires all athletes to have an annual physical. All players must have an athletic physical on file prior to the first practice. Players without physicals will not be allowed to practice and will be required to make up 2 miles for each workout that they miss. Physical paperwork can be downloaded from the school web site at <https://marionisd.rankonesport.com>. The School based clinic is offering physicals throughout the summer for \$10. You must make an appointment by contacting Alicia @ 830.420.2291. Deadline for all physicals to be completed and turned in to the Field House is Friday July 28th.

EQUIPMENT AND ONLINE STORE

Marion ISD provides all football equipment for the upcoming season. Individual athletes are responsible for providing their own cleats. Even though we are moving to a turf field, we will still be playing opponents on their grass fields, it is recommended the players buy molded cleats (avoid injuries by avoiding detachable screw-in cleat models). Shoes are the preference of the player but must be in school colors (black, green, white or gray). ***Again this year, we will partner with BSN Sporting Goods, who is willing to offer a discounted price on common items to our Bulldog family.*** A order flyer has been included. High School Players will be provided with a padded girdle. If players prefer to buy their own, you may do so at your expense. Middle School Players will be required to purchase a girdle for their own personal use. We have a few available for purchase through the school for \$20.

STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING CAMP

The Bulldog Strength and Conditioning Camp is running Monday through Thursday until July 16th. This year has been one of the best on record. If your son is not currently involved, it is never too late to start up.

CUSTOM MOUTH PIECE PROGRAM & ATHLETIC PHYSICAL OFFER

The "school based" Methodist Health Clinic will again be sponsoring custom mouth pieces. Each mouth piece will cost \$5 (this is a \$100 plus value). You must contact the Health Clinic to schedule an appointment at 830-420-2291. Physicals are also offered for just \$10. You must call to make an appointment.

FOOTBALL CAMP

The week of July 31st – Aug 2nd, 2017, we will be holding our annual Football Camp. This camp is open to incoming 3rd to 9th graders. Participation is highly recommended to incoming 7th, 8th and 9th graders to get a jump on their competition. In addition to the advantage gained through mental learning and physical conditioning, we will also issue pads for the upcoming year as part of the camp. Camp cost is \$45. Registrations can be dropped off any time during the summer at the front office of the High School or on the first day of Camp at the Field House.

PRACTICE INFORMATION

Middle School workouts will run from 6:45am to the end of first period. This year we will conduct middle school strength and conditioning workouts at the end of 1st period athletics. Middle school athletes will not have practice after school. All middle school tutorials will be conducted after school. All middle school athletes will be released each morning in time to attend a second chance breakfast at the cafeteria.

BULLDOG LED WORKOUTS

We will begin Senior-led workouts which will be held on July 24th -27th and July 31st – Aug 2nd from 6:00 to 8:00pm. This is a Leadership Council led workout time where the high school kids get together to lift and condition as well as work on football agility and skills. This a voluntary workout, but highly recommended for all incoming 8th through 12th grade football players.

MANDATORY HIGH SCHOOL PLAYER MEETING

We will have a mandatory high school meeting on Wed Aug 23rd at the Field House. The Coaching Staff has put together a series of 6 information sessions to cover the following topics: Practice Information, Recruiting Information, Insurance and Health Care, Injuries – Strength and Conditioning, Academics and Bulldog Moms. After these meetings we will assign lockers and issue practice equipment. All physicals must be completed by this meeting.

BULLDOG MOM MEETING (After Player Meeting)

PLAYING TIME & TEAM DESIGNATION

Evaluations began last November, through the spring and summer, will continue through 2-a-days and throughout the football season. As a practice, we base our decisions in the order of the following criteria:

1. Knowledge of Assignments
2. Mental Toughness and Total Effort
3. Attitude and Work Ethic
4. Hitting Ability and Physical Conditioning
5. Athletic Ability

All kids will get to play, but playing time will not be equal. Playing time is based on practice consistency and performance.

Remember that all evaluations are on-going. Do not become complacent and never miss out on an opportunity to increase your "Stock". If, at any time you want to know where you are at, what you need to be doing, just ask! If you do not agree with our evaluation then prove us wrong. We will play the best players in the best positions to help us achieve the most as a team. This is the Bulldog Way!


